Teachers are enthusiastically embracing a new spelling program called "Soundwaves" and have been very impressed with the quality of the initial assessment, which shows what students can and can't do. "Soundwaves" will complement the "Minilit" program offered by Mrs Storm, Mrs Madden and Ms Innes, to small groups of students who need extra support in this area.
