I saw individuals, pairs and small groups of students working on a range of tasks, including; speech activities, focused comprehension, sight word recognition and a social skills program.

This term, we employed a Speech Pathologist, Tracey Chalmers, who has assessed all kindergarten students' speech and provided a comprehensive outline of interventions required. Mrs Townsend and a teacher's aide will run this program. Correcting speech errors is important as it impacts on literacy development in the future.

Tonight the AGM for our P and C association will be held in the library at 7pm. This will be followed by the regular monthly meeting. All parents and carers are welcome to attend and encouraged to become involved in school life.
