Principal's Report

We have had a busy start to term 1, 2022 with many new changes being implemented across K-6. The most significant is the change to our bell times. We have taken fifteen minutes from the afternoon session and increased our middle session to allow for a systematic numeracy block to be implemented. Staff are following set expectations for both the morning literacy block and the middle numeracy block. This ensures consistency across K-6. Thursday we have moved back to our old lunch bell time of 1:10pm to allow for additional sport time.

We are also changing our school reporting system in that we will not be providing a Term 1 report. Semester 1 & 2 reports will continue, however in Term 1 we will be holding Student Led Conferences. These are interviews run by our students for their parents, discussing goals, achievements and areas to work on. This is a great chance for you to have input into your child's learning. These will be occurring in weeks 10 and 11.
